Thank you for your interest in the UCLA School of Nursing Pre-Licensure Bachelor of Science Transfer Program. The Pre Licensure BS Nursing Program is a three year program for transfer students. This program will focus upon managing both individuals and population-based cohorts within an acute care hospital or medical center. Conceptually, the curriculum has been developed according to the principles of primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention; moving from a systems population-based approach, to a cohort-based or unit-based perspective, and culminating with an intense focus on the individual-level of care. Graduates of the program will be well prepared to deal with the demands of the present day high acuity patient populations and sophisticated technological environments.

Transfer applicants must have completed the IGETC **or** all General Education requirements at the school where currently or previously enrolled and the equivalent of all of the non-nursing pre-major courses listed on the School of Nursing website at <http://nursing.ucla.edu>.

All transfer applicants to the Pre-Licensure Bachelor of Science degree program must complete the UC Application for Admission and Scholarships and the School of Nursing Supplemental Application. The School of Nursing Supplemental Application will allow potential students the opportunity to provide additional information about their preparation for entry into the nursing profession. The deadline for the UC application is **November 30, 2021** and the School of Nursing Supplemental application is **January 15, 2022**.

# BS Transfer Supplemental Application Procedure

Students are admitted for the fall quarter only. The Admission application is available online at [apply.sonnet.ucla.edu](http://apply.sonnet.ucla.edu). Please note that the deadline to submit your application is **January 15<sup>th</sup>**.

## Items that you must submit as part of your online application:

- 1. Statement of Purpose** - Please provide a written statement (2-3 typewritten pages, double spaced) that includes your own assessment of your potential for undergraduate study and for a professional career in nursing, and your reason for selecting the UCLA School of Nursing. You may include information indicating any personal life challenges you have experienced. Multicultural experiences, bilingual abilities and economic, educational or social disadvantages should also be included here. Indicate how your volunteer, work, or other life experiences influenced your decision to pursue a nursing career. **Please upload as a PDF document into the online BS Freshman Application.**
- 2. Work/Volunteer Experience** - In a résumé format listing all employment, volunteer and/or extracurricular activities in chronological order, beginning with the most recent. Please include dates of employment or participation, a brief description of the position or activity, company or agency name and location (city and state). **Please upload your resume as a PDF document into the online application.**
- 3. RECOMMENDATION FORMS – DEADLINE JANUARY 25, 2022**  
List TWO people from whom you are requesting a recommendation. Appropriate sources include one teacher or counselor or one professional who has/had a supervisory, educational or mentoring relationship to you. Recommendations will be accepted from listed recommenders only. **You do not need to send your recommenders the form. They will automatically be emailed a link to complete after you submit the online application.**
- 4. General Education/Pre-major Requirements** – Applicants must list all college coursework completed, in progress, or proposed for the 2021-2022 academic year on the GE and Prerequisite Requirements template.
